Team ESSA-Uniform

- From September you are in full uniform at all times.

- Black shoes. It's that simple.
- In extreme situations you may be allowed to wear uniform from the uniform cupboard.
- Any refusal to wear and you are in Isolation until 4pm.

Team ESSA-Hair and Jewellery

Team ESSA-On Time

- You should be in the school building by 8.35.

- If you are late you will be placed in a minimum 15 minute detention at the end of the day.
- The length of the detention will go up according to how late you are/ how often you are late.
- If you don't want a detention then DON'T BE LATE!!

Team ESSA-Behaviour

- C1-C4 stays.
- Poor behaviour in class or around school will not be tolerated and will result in a detention on the same day.
- You will be given a clear warning to change your behaviour.
- If you do not change your behavior you will be in detention and your parents will be contacted.
- Poor behavior points will be logged in SIMs
- SIMS APP means your parents can now see EXACTLY how you have been behaving in each of your lessons and what rewards you have earned.
